## Fall 2020 Reopening Plan

### Calendar & Schedule

- The academic calendar will remain unchanged. Classes will begin on August 19<sup>th</sup> with every student attending every day.
- Many additional health and safety precautions have been added.
- There will be no field trips.
- Until further notice, only essential staff, volunteers and visitors will be permitted in the buildings.

### Masks

- Grades PK-2 will wear masks on the bus, in the hallway and in common areas.
- Grades 3-12 will wear a mask when changing classes, in the hallways, in common areas and when physical distancing is not possible in the classroom.
- Staff will wear a mask when entering/exiting building, in common areas and when physical distancing is not possible in the classroom.

### Transportation

- Bussing will be provided but parents are encouraged to transport their child.
- Students are required to wear and will receive masks on the bus.
- No more than 2 students per seat and students from the same family may sit together.
- Drivers will load students back to front leaving the first seat empty and will unload front to back in order to lessen contact amongst students.
- Buses will be disinfected at least daily.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers have been installed on all buses.

### Meals

- Breakfast will be “Grab & Go” and be eaten in the classroom at the elementary level.
- Lunches will be eaten in the cafeteria or gymnasium or other designated areas with tables marked for physical distancing.
- Cafeteria and/or gymnasium will be sanitized between lunches.
- Strict handwashing/sanitizing will be observed before and after lunch.
- Disposable items will be used as much as possible.

### Hygiene & Health

- Students and staff will do daily at home wellness check including a temperature check and will stay home if exhibiting symptoms or a temperature over 100 degrees.
- Students will receive a disinfecting wipe upon entering the classroom to wipe down their work area.
- Hand sanitizing/washing will be observed frequently.
- Rigorous cleaning & sanitizing will be observed throughout the day.
- Students are encouraged to bring in a filled water bottle from home daily.

### Classroom Structure

- PK-3<sup>rd</sup> grade will be self-contained and grades 4 & 5 in most cases.
- JHS & JMS students will be switching classes and teachers.
- Students will use the right side of the hallway when traveling to classes.
- Administration will develop a locker schedule at middle school and high school.
- Masks will be worn in the classroom when physical distancing cannot be obtained.
- Outside areas will be utilized for instruction when possible.
- Parents/volunteers entering the school shall conduct a personal screening prior to coming to any building and do not come if you have a temperature above 100 degrees.
- Notify the school of your preference to attend requested meetings in person, via phone or by virtual platform.

### Technology

- Every student will be issued a Chromebook so there is no sharing of devices. Students will bring their charged Chromebook to school every day.
- The district will support families without Wi-Fi as much as possible.
- The district will provide help desk assistance when technology issues occur.
- Hot spots will be made available at all five of our buildings.
