Kindergarten/Preschool Screening Registration

Each year the Jackson City School District conducts Kindergarten Screening during the summer. This two day activity allows the district to provide a comprehensive screening for young children who will be entering the school district in August. This year's registration/screening activities will be held on July 25th and July 26th at Southview Elementary School by appointment only.

All children must be screened before a child can enter school for the first time. Children who should be screened in July include those who will **be five years old on or before August 1, 2018** and plan to attend kindergarten during the 2017-2018 school year or four year olds with a suspected disability. No early admission screenings will be considered. **THIS SCREENING IS FOR STUDENTS WHO DID NOT ATTEND SCREENING IN APRIL, 2018.**

To be eligible for Kindergarten/Preschool Screening, parents must be residents of the Jackson City School District. To register for screening, parents should call Jill Sheets at (740) 286-6442 as soon as possible. Appointment times will be given prior to screening. Registration forms are also available online at www.jcs.k12.oh.us.

Documents needed for screening a child:

1. Certified copy of a birth certificate
2. Certified copy of child custody order(s) if applicable
3. Written evidence of immunizations received
4. Proof of residency [example: utility bill (gas, water, electric), rent receipt]
5. Child will have to have a physical prior to starting school
